## 1) Documents suitable for identification of **Hungarian** citizens (in Hungary):

- Passport
  - Personal ID Card
  - Driving license
- 
- Comply with EU directives, international agreements, conventions, national legislations

# [ Background



## 2) Documents suitable for identification, residence and valid documents for **non-Hungarian** citizens:

- EEA residence permit (valid for max. 5 years)
- EEA personal ID card (valid for max. 90 days)
- Passport of the 3<sup>rd</sup> country citizens' (valid for max. 90 days), the regulations of the visa-agreement(s)
- Domicile permit and personal ID card for domiciled people
- Immigration permit and personal ID card for immigrants
- Documents justifying refugee status and personal ID card for refugees

# e-Client Identification Card (e-ID)



- Identification issued centrally by the State, requested by the natural person (certificate)
- The carrier of the e-ID may be any device (card, telephone SIM card, and other e-memory carriers) suitable for its secure and free of damages storage

# Necessity of the Personal e-identification



- Assuring access to the Governmental services /state, local / via Internet
- Client's authentic personal identification via Internet
- Increase the simplification, standardization (as far as possible) and the reliability of the client registration

# Purpose of the Personal e-Identification



- The system does not replace the traditional personal ID documents but it completes with the opportunity of the personal identification:
- Where to use:
  - Business life
  - Public Administration
  - Education
  - Social Insurance
  - e-Elections, etc.

# Model of Operation



- Centrally issued by the State
- Voluntary applying
- Voluntary activating
- Voluntary change management
- Change management ex officio  
(in case of exchanges in personal ID Doc.)
- Financing:
  - Single service fee is to be paid in case of each apply
  - Validity time max. 2 years
